**APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

**MANAGER'S REPORT**

**Plant Operations** - Mr. Wagner reported the facility was not in compliance for ammonia during the month of February due to the extreme cold temperatures. Mr. Wagner stated the trickling filters have been reseeded and are responding and coming back into operational status. He also reported staff continues to monitor and inspect facilities as part of the FOG (Fats, Oils and Grease) program and a noticeable reduction in grease has been recognized system-wide.

**Pump Station #11 Upgrades** – Mr. Wagner reported all items have been received as part of the Costars Contract with BSI Electrical Contractors for upgrades to Pump Station #11 (7027 Lafayette Avenue). The project may take six to eight months to complete based on the delivery schedule for the generator.

### **SOLICITOR'S REPORT**

**Resolution 2026-05; Service Award and Recognition for Jeannette Quirus** – Mr. Glassman read a Resolution prepared recognizing the dedicated volunteer service of Jeannette Quirus as she serves her last meeting with the Authority this evening. The Resolution will be incorporated into record.
